

HAZARD SUMMARY AND OUTLOOK:

Multiple rounds of heavy rainfall may result in flooding/flash flooding and river flooding Thursday into Friday. Total rainfall amounts between 4 to 8 inches with locally higher amounts at or above 10 inches. Depending on the inland track of the storm, total rainfall amounts may increase into the weekend. There is a lower threat of potentially strong to severe thunderstorms late Thursday into Friday evening.

1. Life Saving

OBJECTIVES:

1. Support/ Initiate search and rescue with the goal of saving the greatest number of endangered lives in the shortest time possible.
2. Fulfill resource request from local governments that support mission priorities.
3. Provide and maintain access control and security in and around the impacted area as necessary for the protection of the affected population while eliminating or mitigating the risk of further damage to persons, property and the environment.
4. Re-establish sufficient communications infrastructure within the impacted areas to ensure the capability to communicate with both emergency responders and the affected populations.
Division A is prepared to conduct missions to support objectives.



