
Governors State of Emergency: 9/08/17



HAZARD SUMMARY AND OUTLOOK:

For the next couple of days, some slight forecast adjustments will occur with both rainfall and wind speeds. The latest update has a slight decrease of winds in AL for Monday into Tuesday. In addition, it appears due to the timing and atmospheric conditions, the tornado threat has also decreased and is very low at this point.

In the tropical storm warning area, which has remained unchanged, sustained winds will be decreasing to 25-35 mph (previously 30-50) with gusts 50-60 mph (previously 70 mph) in southeast AL after midnight Monday, and spreading northward during the day.
