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

HAZARD SUMMARY AND OUTLOOK:

Tropical storm force winds will begin to move into the far southwest and south-central portions of Central Alabama as early as 2 AM and then move northeast through the morning. Wind gusts of 50 to 70 mph may bring down numerous trees and power lines in the southwest portions of the area through 10 AM.

Heavy rainfall will be possible as well and could begin to result in flash flooding through the morning hours. Isolated tornadoes will be possible through the morning hours across our southern counties, expanding north to include much of our eastern and central counties through the day.


