## HAZARD SUMMARY AND OUTLOOK:

For tonight, rain showers will slowly decrease from west to east. Winds will continue to decrease through the evening to 10-15 mph after midnight. Heavy rainfall has moved out of the area, although bands of light to moderate rainfall mainly east of I-65 will be possible overnight. Overnight low temperatures will be in the lower to middle 70s.

A nearby front and tropical moisture will help to keep scattered to numerous showers and storms in the forecast early this week. Tonight, however, rain will gradually taper off as Tropical Depression Nate shifts NE into Tennessee.




