**PROCLAMATION**  
BY THE GOVERNOR

**WHEREAS** I proclaimed a State of Emergency effective May 27, 2018, in response to Tropical Storm Alberto, pursuant to the Alabama Emergency Management Act of 1955, as amended, due to conditions of disaster and of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the State; and

**WHEREAS**, upon the recommendation of officials at the Alabama Emergency Management Agency and after consultation with other affected persons and entities, it has been determined that such conditions no longer exist in the State of Alabama;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of the State of Alabama, do hereby pronounce that the State of Emergency which became effective at 6:00 a.m. CDT, May 27, 2018, shall terminate at 11:59 p.m. on June 5, 2018.

**BE IT ORDERED** that the appropriate Alabama state agencies are hereby instructed to resume their normal state of business and day-to-day operations.
