



STATE OF ALABAMA
PROCLAMATION
BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, on January 28, 2019, I proclaimed a State of Emergency due to the immediate threat of a winter storm system anticipated to cause conditions of disaster and extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the State; and

WHEREAS, upon the recommendation of officials at the Alabama Emergency Management Agency, and after consultation with other affected parties and entities, I have determined that such conditions no longer exist in the State of Alabama;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of the State of Alabama, do hereby proclaim that the State of Emergency declared on January 28, 2019, shall be terminated effective at 9:00 a.m. CST on January 30, 2019.

BE IT ORDERED that all Alabama state agencies are hereby instructed to resume their normal state of business and day-to-day operations.
